REGARDING OUR SILVER JUBILEE YEAR

Indian Academy of Cytologists celebrated its Silver Jubilee Year by hosting a Congress in Bombay after a gap of 22 years. IAC was born in 1970 with 42 founder members in Delhi under the guidance of Dr. P.N. Wahi, the then Director General of ICMR. Today 25 years later the academy has grown with 523 members comprising of not only pathologists and clinicians but cytotechnician and cytotechnologists as well.

The Silver Jubilee year was celebrated throughout the country by conducting workshops, CME, updates at various places like Wardha, Delhi, Chandigarh, Bangalore and Lucknow. These academic activities culminated at Bombay with Six days celebrations comprising of two days preconference workshop on Head and Neck lesions and Thyroid; at Tata Memorial Hospital and two days post conference workshop at Sir H.N. Hospital on Laser and colposcopy. More than 170 persons registered for these workshops.

The megaevent was of two days with lot of academic and gastronomic feasts; jointly hosted by IAC and Association of Medical Women in India (AMWI) attended by more than 250 delegates. On day one Shrin Mehtaji oration was delivered by Jan Stjernswardt of W.H.O.; Academy oration by

Dr. Nagalotimath Dean, Mysore Medical College and Daruwala Oration of AMWI by Joe Jordan and W. Fernandes Oration of AMWI by Adolf Staf. Award papers comprising of Nalinibai Thakker Award for young doctors below 35 years of age and Jwaladevi Award for cytotechnicians & cytotechnologists were presented. Two young doctors from P.G.I.M.E.R. Chandigarh Dr. Uma Nahar and Biman Saikia Shared the honour. Mrs. Rita Purani of B. Nanavati Hospital bagged the Jwaladevi Award.

On the second day Ernest Fernades Award for conducting Diagnostic Slide Seminar was conferred on Dr. Arvind Rajwanshi, Professor of cytopathology at P.G.I.M.E.R. Chandigarh. In addition to this Symposium on Respiratory cytology moderated by Dr. P.K. Agrawal of Lucknow, Jhirad Oration of AMWI delivered by Dr. Usha Luthra (Kuwait); Guest Lectures by Dr. B. Andersh (Sweden) Dr. Peter Kelehan (Ireland) Dr. G. Miniello (Italy) were the highlights of day two of the congress.

A record number of 107 scientific papers were presented at the conference. Poster presentation was introduced for the first time & 25 persons presented their work as posters. Organisers of the Congress awarded two prizes for best posters. Slot one was

bagged by Dr. Shyama Jain of New Delhi and 2nd prize shared by Dr. Manjula Jain of Delhi and Jayashree Joshi of Bombay.

Training Fellowship offered by IAC for 1994-95 was awarded to Narendra Krishnani of Lucknow. In the Cytotechnician & Technologists examination conducted by Accreditation and examination committee of IAC on 10th - 11th Sept. at P.G.I.M.E.R. Chandigarh Mr. Sabuddin Cytotechnologist from Aligarh received Sushil Malhotra Prize for securing highest marks and Ms. Vimal Lingam, Cytotechnician from Madras was receiptant of Bhaskar Reddy award.

12th issue of the Journal of Cytology was also released on the occasion. Along with these academic activities there was a lot of fun at Gallops Restaurant like the parade of past presidents, founder members & guest speakers. Witty question answer sessions, melodious songs by Dr. Miniello and Geeta Jayaram. Lucky draw during the valedictory function had many surprises & Prizes. So most of the delegates left with their hands full of prizes including the best of Govan wines. Executive & General Body Meeting was also held during the Congress. Many important decisions were taken including fixing the Venue for the 26th Congress at Calcutta.

EXAMINATION FOR CYTOTECHNICIAN AND CYTOTECHNOLOGISTS (2nd & 3rd September, 1996)

The Indian Academy of Cytologists is planning to conduct the examination for cytotechnologists and cytotechnicians on 2nd & 3rd September, 1996 at Govt. Medical College, Nagpur.

Eligibility criteria for cytotechnologists examination are :

M.Sc. Medical Lab. technology with cytology as special subject.

OR

B.Sc. Medical Lab technology with experience in cytology for one year.

OR

5 years experience in cytology as lab technician following diploma in MLT.

OR

5 years experience in cytology as lab technician following passing the cytotechnicians exam, conducted by IAC.

Eligibility criteria for cytotechnician examination are :

Higher Secondary in biological sciences with diploma in MLT/certificate course and 6 months experience in cytology.

OR

Higher Secondary in biological sciences with 5 yrs. experience in cytology.

Those desirous of appearing in the examination may write for detailed form and course contents. **Last date for receipt of applications is 30th June, 1996.**

4. Sushil Malhotra Award : Cytotechnologist standing first in the national examination conducted by the IAC.
5. Dr. Satya Monga Award : For paper published in the field of immunocytochemistry.
