Message from the President

Indian Academy of Cytologists

Dear Members of the Academy,

Warm greetings! The monsoon season in ongoing and with saavan, come good tidings after the hot and harsh summer. The trees are lush and green and one's thoughts are towards striving for something fresh. I urge all members to attend the CYTOCON 2024 being hosted by Dr. Poonam Elhence and her team in AlIMS, Jodhpur in November.



During my term as Secretary, we celebrated the Golden Jubilee of our Academy amidst the raging pandemic. We faced the toughest of challenges but persisted and succeeded. Many lessons were learnt, foremost of which was the Online formats for meetings. What began as a necessity is now a 'trend' with the previous and current CYTOCON 2024 being held in a 'Hybrid' mode thereby engaging more delegates. Still, I urge all members of the academy to attend the conference physically as far as possible.

The second thought in my mind is how one can increase the skilled human resources in cytopathology. Dr.Kusum Verma, former President and our guiding light, had pointed to me many years ago that we are lagging behind countries like the US, and that creation of Cytopathology fellowships was the need of the hour. The IAC offers up to 4 fellowships from its limited resources which was for just 1 month duration initially and since last 2 years, when I was Secretary, we increased the duration to a maximum of 3 months. Dr.Rajwanshi, another former President of IAC, had the foresight to start a Post-doctoral Certificate course (PDCC), now designated Cytopathology Fellowship, nearly 3 decades ago in PGI which was for 1-year duration. This was a first for the country and has provided training to many students. A few more handful of institutes have started such fellowship courses but overall this is too little for a country of 1.5 billion! It needs a massive upgrade in terms of numbers and each AIIMS like institute, RCCs. Medical colleges with good Cytopathology set-ups must all start Fellowship/s in Cytopathology to fill in this yawning gap. On part of the IAC, we need to liberalize the system. We can take a leaf from the model adopted by the Indian College of Pathologists (ICP) which allows for Fellowships across various sub-speciality disciplines which are unpaid, do not need an entrance exam but is open to anyone with an MD Pathology degree, is under a mentor, of 1-year duration and has an exit examination with an external examiner. This would allow many students pursuing their Senior Residency in several institutions across the country to become eligible. The ICP model has generated numerous Fellows in Nephropathology across the country which has helped set up Transplant Pathology in both the public and the private sector. This is a wake-up call for IAC and this is one model that is feasible in the immediate scenario.

We are also slowly but surely moving into the digital era with Whole slide Imaging and diagnostic algorithms. Indeed, AIIMS, New Delhi has taken the lead in this which was showcased in numerous workshops during our Golden Jubilee conference. Dr.Andrey Bychkov from Japan, will be elaborating on this topic in the upcoming CYTOCON. However, on the downside, I strongly feel that we are ignoring the basics. Many young pathologists hardly are capable of performing FNA to obtain good material which is a very basic step before we embark on advanced ancillary techniques like Flow cytometry or molecular testing. The vast majority of centers perform FNA without a handle compromising on adequate material for cell block preparation and other tests. Image-guided FNA is performed solely by radiologists rather than teaming with cytopathologists even in many academic centers, what to speak of the private centers. This is a wake-up call for IAC to start workshops on good FNA practices and a humble start is being made in the form of a freeworkshop in the current CYTOCON. Lastly my thoughts are on how the separated disciplines of cytopathology and histopathology are now merging in the WHO Blue book series thanks to the efforts of the International Academy. This has implications in the way we teach cytopathology to GenX, which should ideally get integrated while teaching histopathology of any particular system. We have to adapt to the changing scenario and evolve to become better cytopathologists. 






Case 2:
